Who Can Take our Program?

The Youth Business Development Program is for people interested in creating a job for themselves by starting their own business. This may be full time or part time.

You may be eligible for our program, if you are:

Within the ages of 16-30

Not attending school

Are not self employed or receiving minimal income from self employment

Do not qualify for Employment Insurance

Receiving minimal Social Assistance

The Youth Business Development Program consists of Business Plan Development Training, One on One Consulting Services, Access to Financing (through our financial partners), Money Management Training and Aftercare/Mentorship Services. You may even be eligible for a 6 month training allowance while developing your business plan!

Service Description

Business Plan Development Training

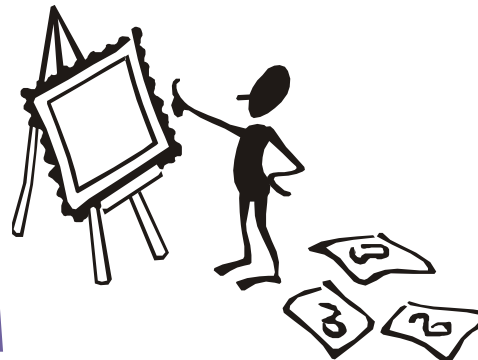
Our Business Plan Development Training is 6 weeks in length.

Each session covers a section in the business plan. The homework is to complete that same section using your business idea. A draft of the business plan will be complete by the end of the 6 weeks of training.



One to One Consulting Services

Once the training and draft business plan are complete, clients advance to One on One Consulting. Here clients work with a business counselor to revise and complete the business plan.



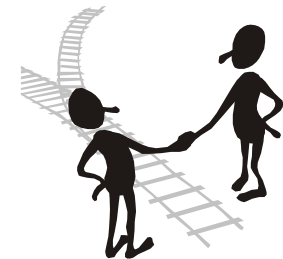
Services Continued

Saving Circle & Money Management Training

Clients also take part in our Saving Circle program where they learn the basics of money management and have their savings matched at a rate of 3:1.

Access to Financing

After completing the business plan and the research shows that the business idea will work, clients may apply for a small loan through one of our financial partners.



Aftercare/Mentorship

Monthly meetings with a business counselor are available for up to a year after the business has been started. In these meetings clients can discuss any projects, issues or problems that may arise during the first year of business.
